Ministry/Charity Fundraisers



We are excited that God has given us the means to help your ministry raise funds for serving in His name. Here are some guidelines for having a successful fundraiser with us.

- 1. Your fundraiser must be affiliated with an established church or charity (non-profit).
- 2. Your organization receives 100% of the bowling and shoe rental proceeds during your scheduled time. Concession sales will go toward Grace Lanes operating costs.
- 3. Because we only plan one fundraiser a month, understand that your fundraiser, after approved, may be several months out.
- 4. Please don't announce your fundraiser until all details have been finalized.
- 5. Have one representative from your ministry present during your fundraiser OR have a "booth" set up with information about your ministry/charitable organization. This is a great opportunity for your organization to mingle with bowlers and share its purpose and vision.
- 6. If you can, please have your representatives wear name tags or clothing that identifies him/her/them with your ministry or home church/organization affiliation.
- The bowling alley will be open to the community during your fundraiser event. This serves two purposes: 1. Maximum fundraising for your event, and 2. A family day for the community.
- 8. Regular prices for games and shoes apply.
- 9. Let us know if you want to reserve lanes and times for your church/organization members to bowl together.
- 10. At the end of the night, we will write your ministry a check for the total shoes and bowling sales.
- 11. If you create an "Event" on Facebook, please share it with us or add us as a "co-host". You are responsible for advertising your event, but we will do our best to help you get the word out.
- 12. Only Grace Lanes employees will be allowed to work behind counters.
- 13. Feel free to set up a silent auction or donation box but you must provide someone to monitor that activity. You will be completely responsible for that and/or any other equipment/materials.
